







PLEASE NOTE :The minimum and maximum adjustment sizes noted on the product brochures are based on perfectly plumb walls and trays.





IMPORTANT - Installation site

- 1. Ensure the top surface of the shower tray on which the enclosure will be installed is level in every direction.
- 2. The tiles or other wall finishings should be effectively sealed at tray edges.
- 3. Tiles should extend at least to the corner of the tray and a minimum of 1.9 meters from the top of the tray.

PROCEDURE



TRAY MUST BE 100% LEVEL IN ALL DIRECTIONS


Ensure the shower tray is level in all directions and is properly sealed to the wall. The wall must be tiled down to the top edge of the tray. **Do not angle out bottom tile.**

TRAY MUST BE SEALED FULLY AROUND WHERE THE TRAY MEETS THE WALL.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


Note: The product can be constructed either way up, for left or right hand opening. This instruction is showing a LEFT hand opening.



- Step 1.1 Place the wall profile to the wall (roughly 10mm away from the front edge of the tray. (Diagram A.1).
- Step 1.2 Level the profile using a spirit level. Once you are happy that the profiles sits on the tray correctly, mark the wall through the 4 pre-drilled holes in the wall profiles(no.1) (Diagram A.2)

Note: You may find it easier to mark and drill the wall if you apply masking tape to it first.

- Step1.3 Remove the wall profile and drill the marked points using a 6mm masonry drill bit. Once this is done, insert wall plugs (no.2)(Diagram A.3)
- Step 1.4 Fix the wall profiles(no.1) to the wall using the screws ST4X45(no.3)(Diagram A.4).




- Step 2.1 Place the closing profile (no.4) onto the wall (roughly 10mm away from the front of the tray.(Diagram A.5).
- Step 2.2 Level the profile using a spirit level. Once you are happy that the profile sits on the tray correctly, mark the wall through the 4 holes at the top and bottom of the profile through the top cap fixing. (Diagram A.6).

Note: You may find it easier to mark and drill the wall if you apply masking tape to it

- Step2.3 Remove the profile and drill the marked points using a 6mm masonry drill bit. Once this is done, insert the wall plugs(no.2) (Diagram A.7)
- Step 2.4 Fix the closing profile to the wall using the screws ST4x45(no.3)(Diagram A.8).
- Step 2.5 Insert the bottom rail into the closing profile approximately 12mm.(Diagram A.9).

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


- Step 3.1 Fit the glass edge cover (no.11) onto the bottom rail (Diagram B). Ensure the screw holes on the fixing strip line up the holes on the rail profile (Diagram C). Insert the washers (no.28) into the glass holes at the bottom of the fixed panel, then carefully lift the fixed panel insert it into the bottom rail and wall profile.(Diagram D)
- Step 3.2 Follow the same steps as above to fit the top rail.(Diagram E).
- Step 3.3 Fit the glass blocker (no.10) onto the notch at the top of the fixed panel. (Diagram F).





- Step 4.1 Ensure the glass holes on the rail profile line up with the holes on the fixed panel and glass fixing strip. Press the horizontal fixing seal (no.15) into the rail profiles to to attach the fixed panel then secure the parts together using 4 screws M5 x14 (no.7). (Diagram G).
- Step 4.2 Insert the closing bubble seal (no.29) into the closing profile, then fix the top cap onto the closing profile using 2 screws M4x10(no.30). Fix the top cap together with the top rail using a screw ST 3.5x20 (no.23) (Diagram H)
- Step 4.3 Fix the wall profile top cap onto the wall profile using 3 screws ST 3.5x20(no.23) (Diagram I)
- Step 4.4 Press the vertical fixing seal (no.19) into the wall profile from bottom to top to secure the glass panel (Diagram J).

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Step 5 Fit the top/bottom rollers(no.16/17) onto the door panel (Diagram L1/L2), ensure the easy clean side face the inside of the shower door. Carefully lift the door panel into the top rail profile then using the quick release mechanism on the bottom rollers guide them into the bottom rail profile.(Diagram K).






Step 6 Adjust the screw at the bottom of the top roller to raise or lower the door panel so it's 100% level with the fixed panel. Use the same technique if the wheels do not fit into the bottom rail.

(Diagram M).

Step 7 Move the roller stoppers (no.24/25) to make it stay at the perfect position then secure them onto the rail profiles by using the allen wrench to tighten the grub screw on the roller stopper. Next fit the cover cap on. Fit the rail profile end caps (no.26/27) onto the top and bottom rail profile. (Diagram N).

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Step 7 Fit the F fixed panel seal(no.20-1) onto the fixed panel(Diagram O1), fit the F moving glass seal(no.20-2) onto the moving glass. (Diagram O2)

Step 8 Fit the handle (no.18) onto the door panel.(Diagram P1/P2/P3).



DO NOT USE THE ENCLOSURE FOR 24 HOURS AFTER SEALING

Applying Silicone Sealant

Sealing Inside

Seal from the top of the wall profile to the bottom on the **INSIDE** between the wall profile and the wall.

IMPORTANT: Do not apply sealant on inside of the tray.

Sealing Outside

Seal from the top of the wall profile to the bottom between the wall profile and tiles on both sides. Also seal along the bottom where the frame meets the tray. Seal the joints between the bottom profile and any upright profiles.

AFTERCARE

IMPORTANT – Cleaning and Aftercare

You should never use any abrasive cleaning supplies on your glass shower door. Additionally, it is important to wipe down all the glass and metal parts with a soft cloth after every use to remove residual water.

Do not use abrasive cleaning products that contains harsh chemicals, bleach or ammonia etc. These products will damage the glass and will corrode the shower door's frame and metallic parts over time.

Do not clean any seals with strong cleaning chemicals. Using abrasives cleaners will damage seals and can then cause them to leak. Protect the seals by only cleaning them with a mild soap and warm water after use and to prevent any build-up of chemicals and limescale.

We do highly recommend that moving parts and hinges, are checked regularly to ensure they are clean, correctly positioned and operating smoothly.

Caring for your shower door properly will ensure it lasts a long time, remember to only use warm soapy water and a soft cloth and to wipe away any soap scum etc to avoid any corrosion.

Usage

For reliable, watertight performance from the enclosure your shower head should not be positioned so that the shower sprays directly onto the enclosure door. Failure to comply with this may cause the shower to leak. Outward opening doors may cause water to drip onto the floor, please ensure that the floor covering immediately outside the enclosure will not be affected by water.





This product has been applied with an easy clean glass treatment, a protective barrier which creates a 'non-stick' surface on your glass, helping to resist lime scale build up and water spots.
